

**NOTICE OF MEASURE
TO ACHIEVE A LEGITIMATE OBJECTIVE UNDER CHAPTER 7
OF THE AGREEMENT ON INTERNAL TRADE**

APPROVED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF QUÉBEC

Occupation: Denturist

Province(s)/Territory(ies) whose workers are affected:

British-Columbia, Nova-Scotia, Prince-Edward-Island, North-West-Territories, Yukon and Nunavut

Under which legitimate objective(s) is the measure being filed:

Public security, protection of human life and health.

Rationale/Justification:

The practice of Denturology in Quebec requires from professionals the mastering of sufficient competencies, knowledge and abilities to practice in an autonomous fashion, i.e. apart from dentist supervision. The professionals from affected provinces and territories practice under the supervision of a dentist, not directly with patients and cannot make “partials”. These activities represent the main jobs undertaken by a denturist in Québec. To issue denturist certificate, the Ordre des denturologistes du Québec must require additional training.

Additional Requirement(s):

A professional who files a request for certification to the Ordre des denturologistes du Québec on grounds of a certificate delivered by an authorized regulatory authority of a Party to the Agreement on internal Trade whose workers are affected will have to demonstrate, to the Ordre’s satisfaction, that he has mastered the competencies, knowledge and abilities related to the autonomous practice of denturology through a file evaluation, successful completion of the prescribed missing training and the passing of the appropriate exam.
