Rationale/Justification: Material Scope of Practice Difference In Alberta there are 4 distinct areas of practice for this profession: radiological technologists, nuclear medicine technologists, magnetic resonance technologists and radiation therapists. Both Quebec and Nova Scotia provide a general license which does not indicate which stream the individual is practicing. In addition, these 2 provinces regulate sonographers under a general license and this profession is not regulated in Alberta.	
Additional Requirement(s): Individual assessment of the education credentials and experience of regulated members from Quebec and Nova Scotia is required to determine in which areas the individual is competent to practice has been practicing.	
Anticipated Duration of the additional requirement(s): Indefinite
