The scope of practice of a social worker in New Brunswick includes the provision of social work diagnosis and psycho-social intervention. These activities are not part of the scope of practice of diploma graduates in both Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Additional Requirement(s):

The applicants will be required to complete the courses required to obtain a BSW before being issued a license to practice as a registered social worker in New Brunswick.
